Eligibility Criteria

Age: 18 years and over

This study is NOT accepting healthy

Healthy Volunteers: volunteers

Inclusion Criteria:

- diagnosis of extensive alopecia areata - women of childbearing age must agree to use an acceptable, highly effective method of birth control to prevent pregnancy

Exclusion Criteria:

- women who are pregnant or breast feeding - current controlled or uncontrolled infection of any type - systemic therapy for cancer within the past five years except for adequately treated Squamous Cell Carcinoma (SCC) or Basal Cell Carcinoma (BCC) of the skin - additional medical conditions, treatments for alopecia areata, or mental health diagnosis (study staff will review)
