- 7 to 99 years old - diagnosed with chronic, intractable (drug refractory) primary dystonia determined by a neurologist or neurosurgeon

- patients who are at significant surgical risk as determined by the neurosurgeon and/or anesthesiologist - patients who have not had an adequate trial of medical or nonsurgical treatment
