Inclusion Criteria:

1. Anorexia Nervosa Participants: females between 18- 50 years old who meet criteria for diagnosis of Anorexia Nervosa 1. Healthy Participants: healthy females age between 18-50, no previous diagnosis of Anorexia Nervosa or other psychiatric disease.

Exclusion Criteria:

1. Meets criteria for substance abuse disorder or actively suicidal 2. Neurological condition or other developmental disorder 3. MRI contraindication 4. Inability to read English
